

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
Demographics – Age, Nativity, Race/Ethnicity



Residents ages 55 and older are 22.1% of the city's population




Older age cohorts account for nearly 10% of Boston's population growth from 2010 to 2030




32.4% of West Roxbury's population is 55+




Boston's oldest populations are more likely to be White or Asian




The Hispanic population 55 and older in Boston has nearly doubled since 2010




38.7% of older Boston residents are foreign born, a much higher share than in Massachusetts and the country




Boston's elderly foreign-born population is more likely to be naturalized




Boston's oldest residents are less likely to speak English proficiently




~15,000 older Spanish speakers and almost 7,000 older Haitian speakers have limited English proficiency



20% of the population 55 and older live with adult children




5% of householders aged 65-74 have grandchildren living with them




02 Employment and Income




Labor force participation declines with age, but nearly 30% of 65-74 year olds are employed



As households leave the labor force, their income declines




With declining employment and increased likelihood of living alone, older residents are poorer






Older householders are more likely to live in owner occupied housing




Increased housing costs make it more difficult for the aging population to remain in Boston

Nearly half of the population 85 and older lives alone




04 Disability




ACS measure of disability

- The ACS identifies *serious difficulty* with four basic areas of functioning hearing, vision, cognition, and ambulation.
- In addition, questions address difficulties with selected activities from the Katz Activities of Daily Living (ADL), such as dressing, feeding, and bathing (self care); and Lawton Instrumental Activities of Daily Living (IADL) such as managing finances, meal preparation, and medications (independent living)


Disability increases with age and makes it more difficult to for people to remain in housing not designed for the needs of an aging population




Blacks and Hispanics have increased disability




Vision and hearing difficulty increases with age




Walking and cognitive difficulty increases with age

With increased disability, self-care becomes more difficult




The aging population relies on personal care workers

- Hourly wage of full-time personal care workers is \$17.51 slightly above the Massachusetts minimum wage of \$15.00
- 82.1% of personal care workers are female, compared to 48.5% of the labor force
- 45.8% of personal care workers are foreign born, compared to only 28.4% of the labor force


05 Mortality




Death rates for the older population are lower in Suffolk County than the nation



Death rates increased in 2020 due to Covid but fell in Suffolk County in 2021




Vaccine uptake and high quality medical care helped bring down death rates in Suffolk County

Age Strong in Boston

- Boston's population ages 70 and older is projected to to grow at a faster rate from 2010 to 2030.
- 17.3% of this population has self-care difficulty and 26.5% has independent-living difficulty.
- Boston's population 55 and older is more likely to be foreign born, White, and Asian compared to the city's population.
- As this population ages, it is more likely to live alone and in poverty.
- During COVID-19, this population experience increased mortality but below that of the rest of the country.
