

MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED REGULAR MEETING

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Mr. Donald Graham, Administrator of the Planning Section, attended the meeting at this point and discussed planning activities and functions currently being carried out as well as the status of planning for renewal projects.

After Mr. Graham left the meeting, the Authority went into executive session to discuss a proposed reorganization plan.

On motion duly made and seconded, it was unanimously

VOTED: to approve and distribute the following news release:

"Members of the Boston Redevelopment Authority invited Edward J. Logue, the Mayor's adviser on redevelopment matters, to meet with them today.

"Mr. Logue did not attend today's meeting. He was in Pittsburgh at a meeting held by the Democratic National Committee.

"The conference with Mr. Logue has been re-scheduled for "Wednesday, Columbus Day.

"The Members of the Redevelopment Authority reiterate their approval of the Mayor's proposed \$90 million rehabilitation program and urge once again that steps be taken immediately to file an application for the \$20 million in Federal funds which the Mayor says are available.

"Even though the program proposed by the Mayor and Mr. Logue could be improved upon, we are entirely willing to go along with it in order to get it rolling.

"We believe the application for Federal funds should be filed at once. We can see no reason for any delay.

"If the Mayor adopts the position that no application for Federal funds can be processed and filed unless one individual is designated to run the redevelopment program, he must accept the responsibility for any delay which results. "

On motion duly made and seconded, it was unanimously

VOTED: to adjourn.
