North Side

Approximated dimensions = 70' width by 15' height
Material: Brick wall

South Side

Storage container approximated dimensions = 40' length by 8' height and 10' width by 8' height

Material: Corrugated Steel

Wall approximated dimensions = 20' width by 12' height
