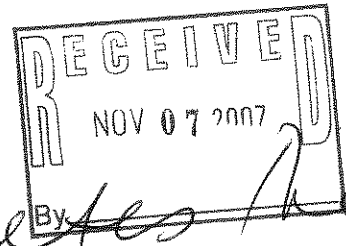

At your request, last month we contacted members of the original "Fort Point Channel Abutters Group" and convened a meeting of the group on October 25, 2007 at the Seaport World Trade Center.

At that meeting the Abutters Group selected Michael A. Cantalupa, Senior Vice President, Development for Boston Properties to serve as its representative to the Fort Point Channel Watersheet Operations Board. The City of Boston's Municipal Harbor Plan called for the Board's creation.

As you will recall, the Abutters Group consists of representatives of the Fort Point Channel's landowners (see attached list) as well as representatives of the Boston Tea Party Ship and Museum, Boston Parks and Recreation, and Save the Harbor / Save the Bay, which chaired the planning process that produced the award winning Fort Point Channel Watersheet Activation Plan.


Please note that in some cases ownership has changed since the plan was drafted. In those cases, representatives of the new landowners were also invited to participate in the discussion and selection process.
