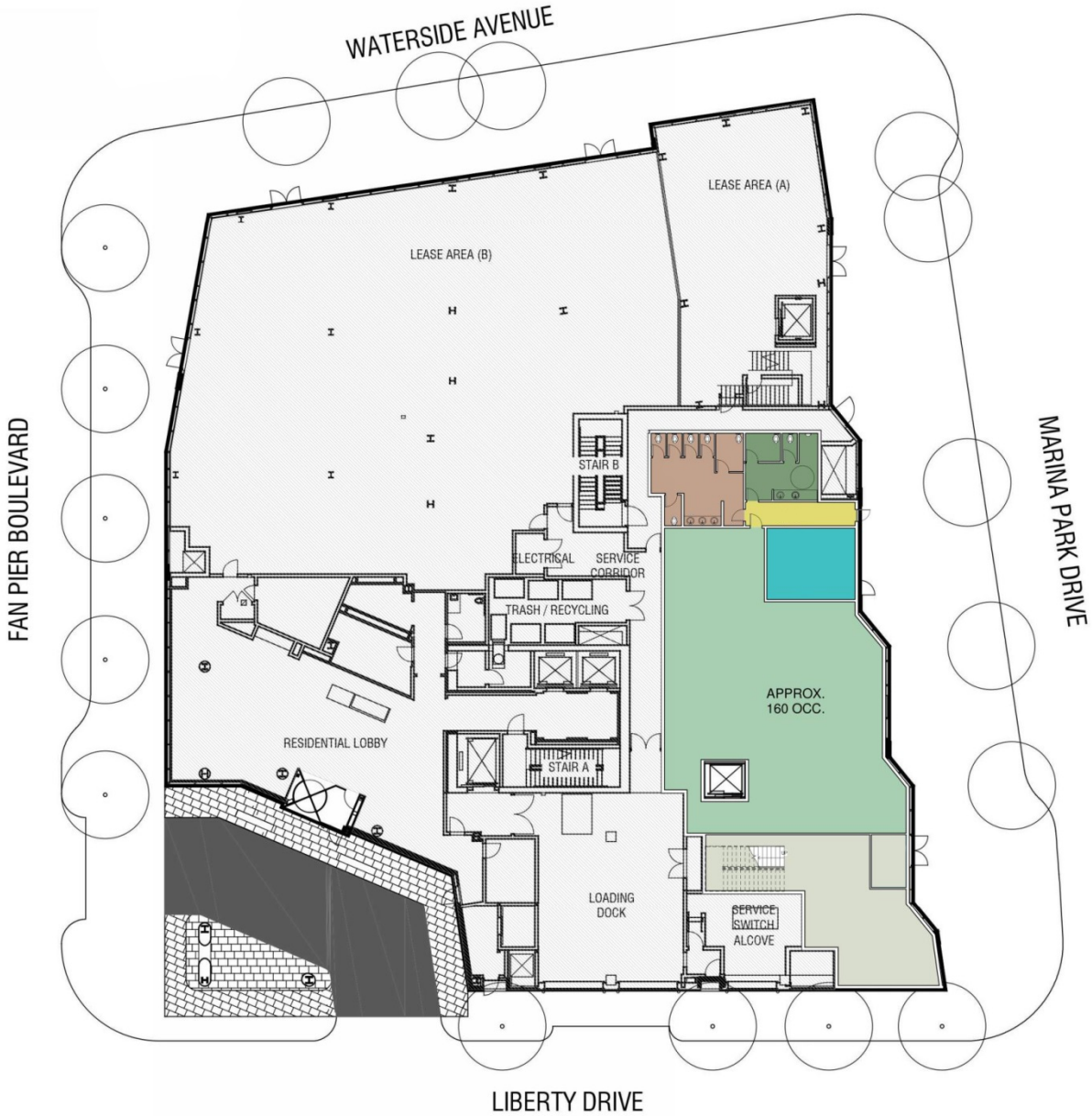

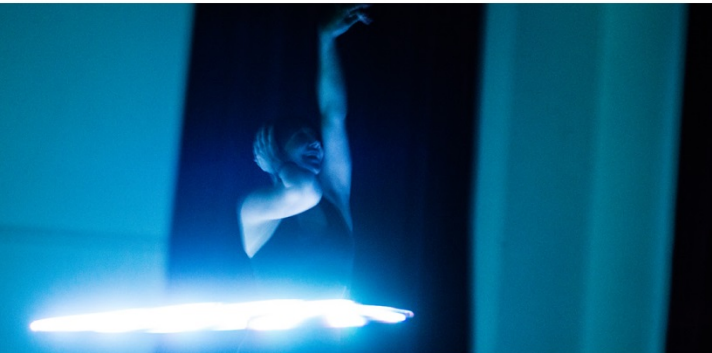
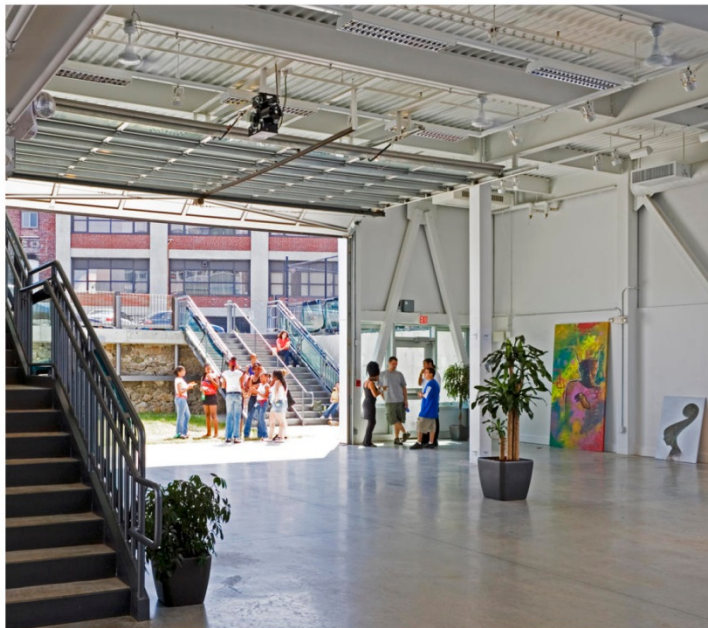
- Vertical connection with on-site residents

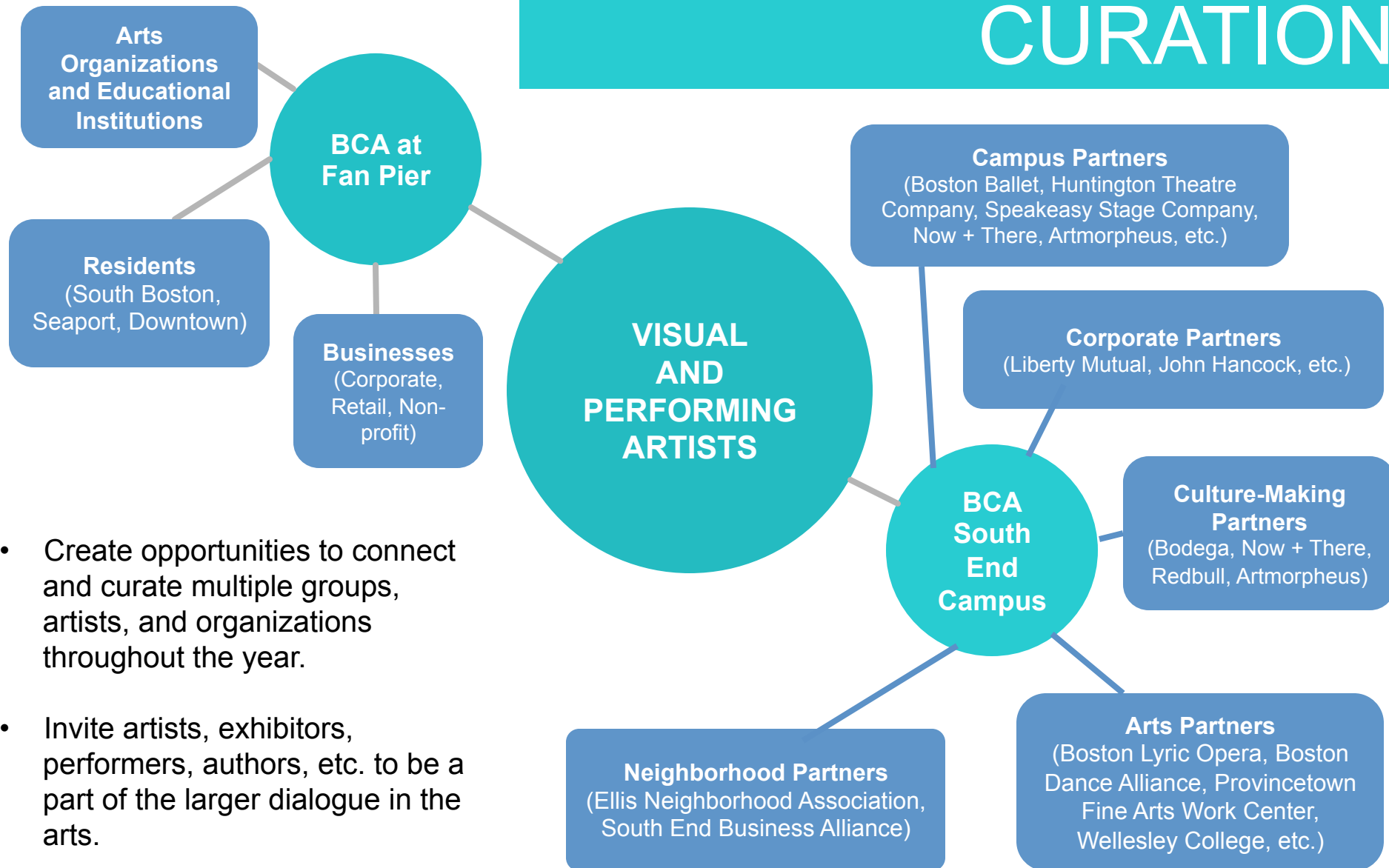
