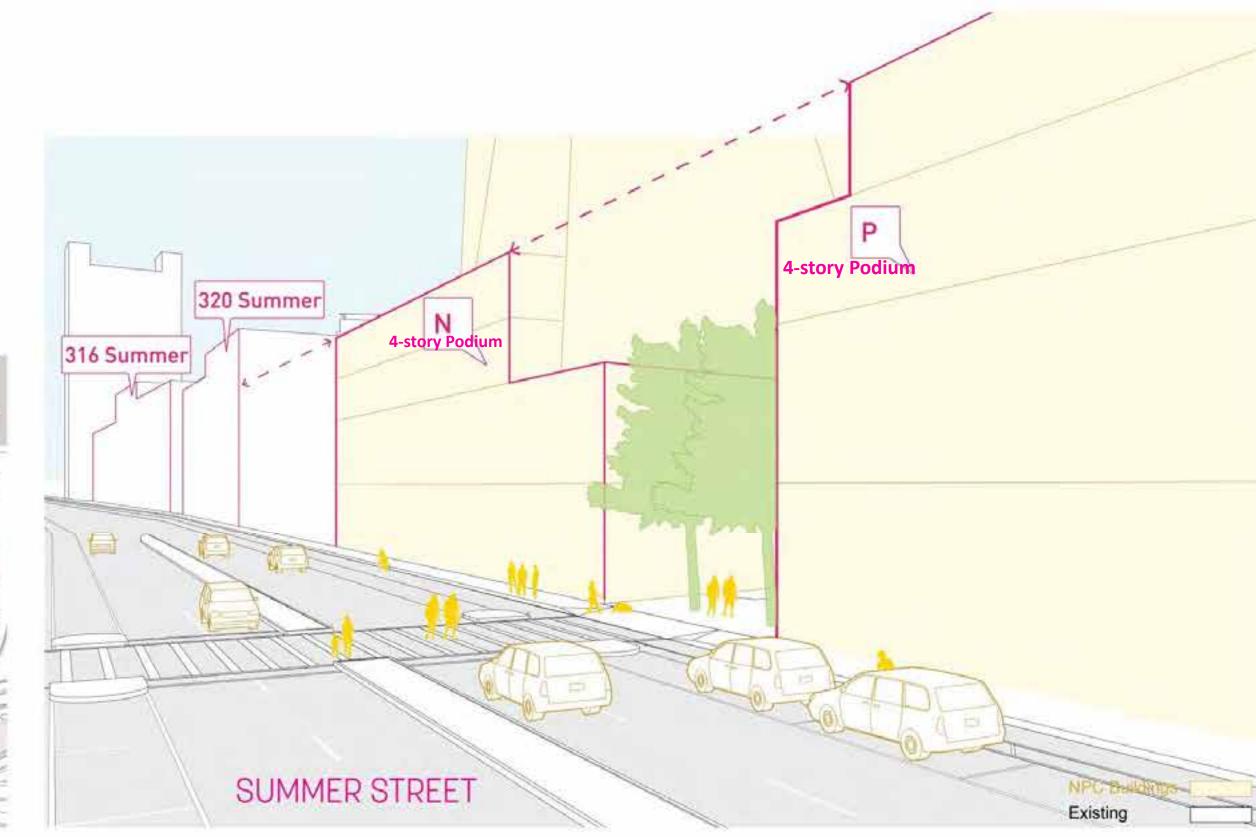

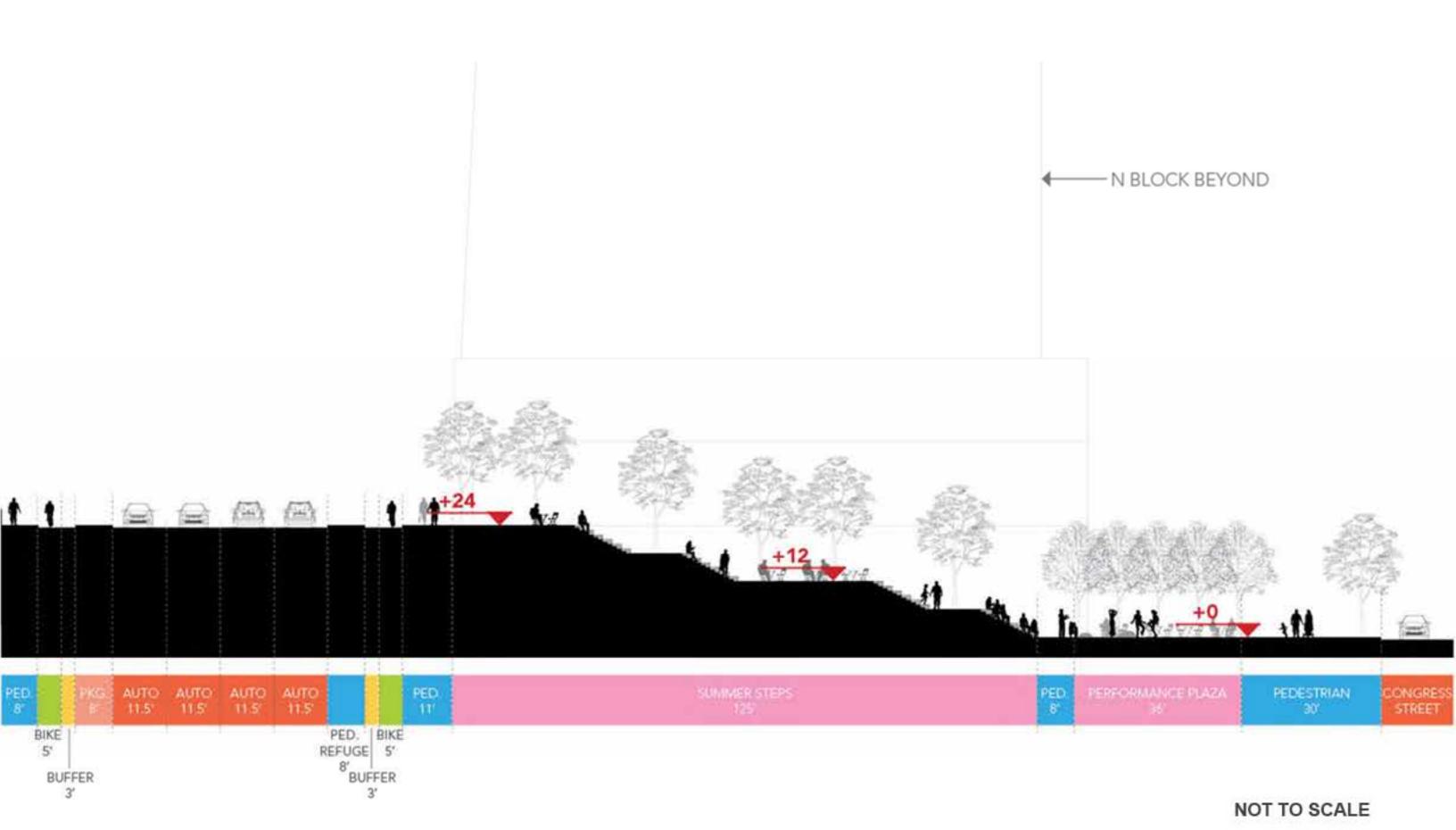

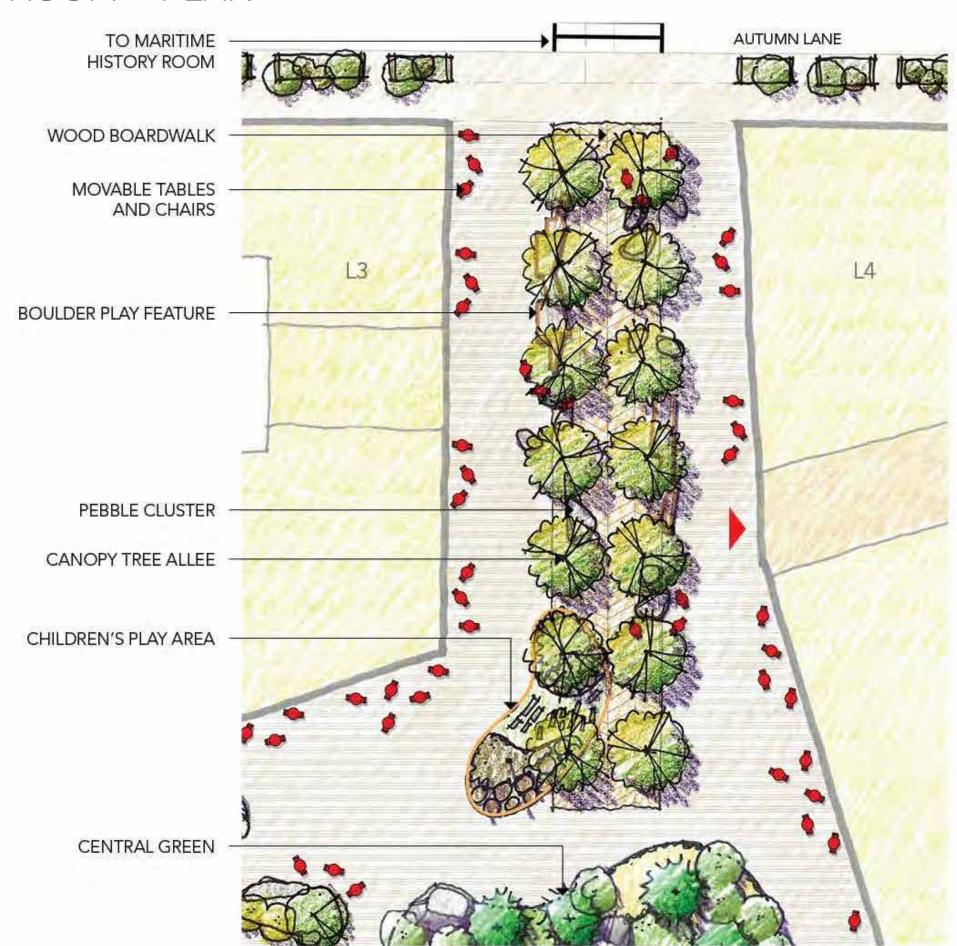


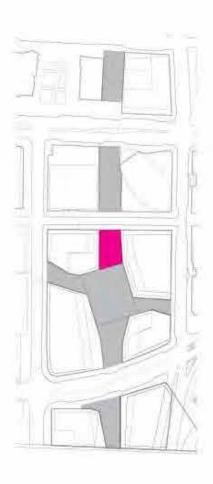


HARBOR LANE WEST VIEW TO CENTRAL GREEN

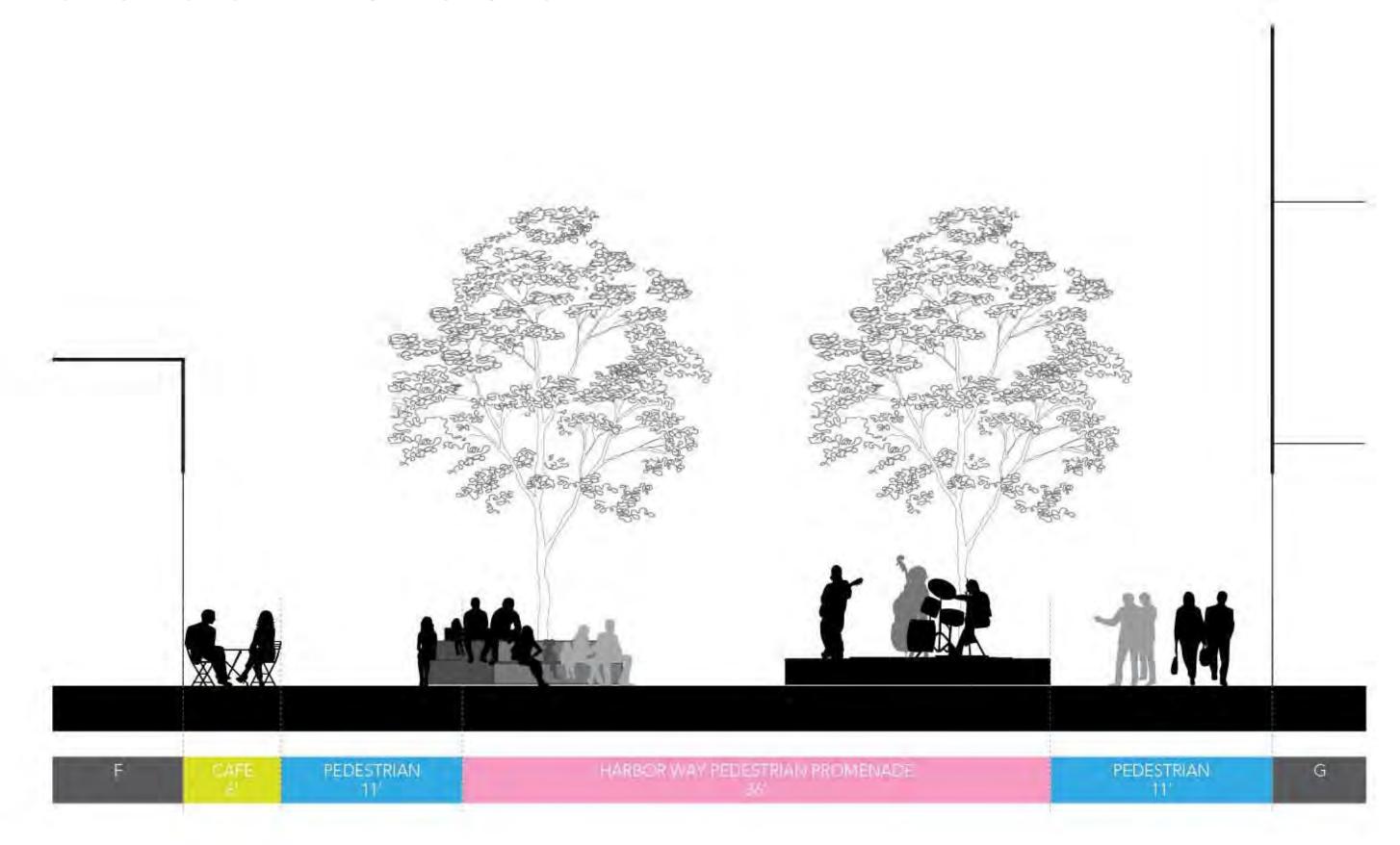
