

## 14,442 Boston Residents were born in Cape Verde and/or reported Cape Verdean Ancestry




Median Age: 36

20% speak English not well or not at all


**\$40,000** median earnings for full-time workers

**65%** of Boston residents with Cape Verdean Ancestry live in Dorchester




**64%** of the U.S. population with Cape Verdean Ancestry live in Massachusetts (**12%** live in just Suffolk County)

Top U.S. Counties for Cape Verdean Ancestry



# 28,859 Boston Residents were born in Haiti or reported Haitian Ancestry




Median Age: 38

**19%** speak English not well or not at all


\$36,000 median earnings for full-time workers


**15%** of Hyde Park and **13%** of Mattapan residents report Haitian ancestry

#### SOMALIANS & UGANDANS IN BOSTON

1,605 Boston Residents were born in Somalia/reported Somalian Ancestry. For Ugandans this number was 166.





Median Age: 26.5

77% speak a language other than English at home, with the most common being Somali for Somalians and Ganda for Ugandans.

6.4% speak English not well/not at all

\$31,000 median earnings for full-time workers





The majority of Ugandans in Massachusetts (82%) live in Middlesex County. 52% live in three specific towns: Waltham (860 people), Acton (701 people), and Billerica (654 people)
