


DOMINICANS IN BOSTON (1980-2020)





DOMINICAN MIGRATION TO MASSACHUSETTS HAS SLOWED SINCE 2018


DOMINICAN MIGRATION TO MASSACHUSETTS SINCE 1960




THE SHARE OF U.S.-BORN DOMINICANS IS INCREASING



New York, **New Jersey,** Florida, Massachusetts, and Pennsylvania are the Top 5 **States where Dominicans live**




Lawrence, Boston, Lynn, Methuen, and **Worcester are** the Top 5 Cities or Towns where **Dominicans** live




DOMINICANS IN BOSTON ARE A YOUNGER POPULATION

MEDIAN AGE




NEARLY A THIRD OF BOSTON'S DOMINICANS ARE CHILDREN

AGE CATEGORIES




FOREIGN-BORN DOMINICAN WOMEN DISPROPORTIONATELY CONTRIBUTE TO BOSTON'S BIRTHS



DOMINICANS 5 YEARS AND OLDER




DOMINICAN ADULTS HAVE LOWER EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT THAN BOSTON'S ADULT POPULATION




DOMINICAN YOUNG ADULTS ARE LESS LIKELY TO BE ENROLLED IN COLLEGE

AGES 18-TO-29 YEARS




DOMINICAN WORKERS ARE LESS LIKELY TO BE WORKING THAN OTHER BOSTON PODUI ATIONS




DOMINICANS FILL JOBS IN BUILDING & GROUNDS, & CLEANING

BUSINESS OWNER SHARES




DOMINICANS EARN LESS PERSONAL INCOME THAN BOSTON WORKERS

PERSONAL INCOME - FULLTIME WORKERS





DOMINICANS IN BOSTON ARE LESS LIKELY TO LIVE IN OWNER-OCCUPIED


OWNER-OCCUPIED HOUSING SHARES



DOMINICAN RENTERS ARE MORE LIKELY TO BE RENT-COST BURDENED


SHARE RENT-COST BURDENED HOUSEHOLDS

HOUSEHOLD INCOME CATEGORIES





A GREATER SHARE OF BOSTON'S DOMINICAN CHILDREN LACK HEALTH INSURANCE


SHARES LACKING HEALTH INSURANCE AGES BIRTH-TO-18 YEARS
