

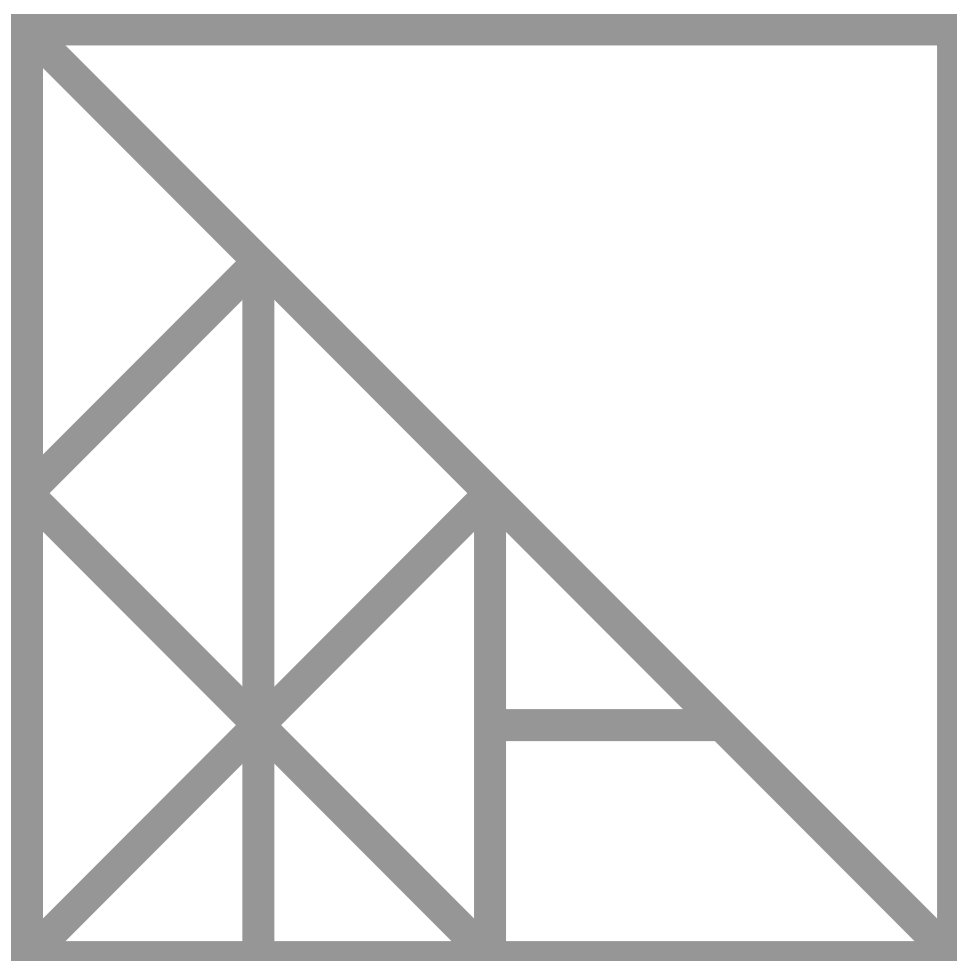

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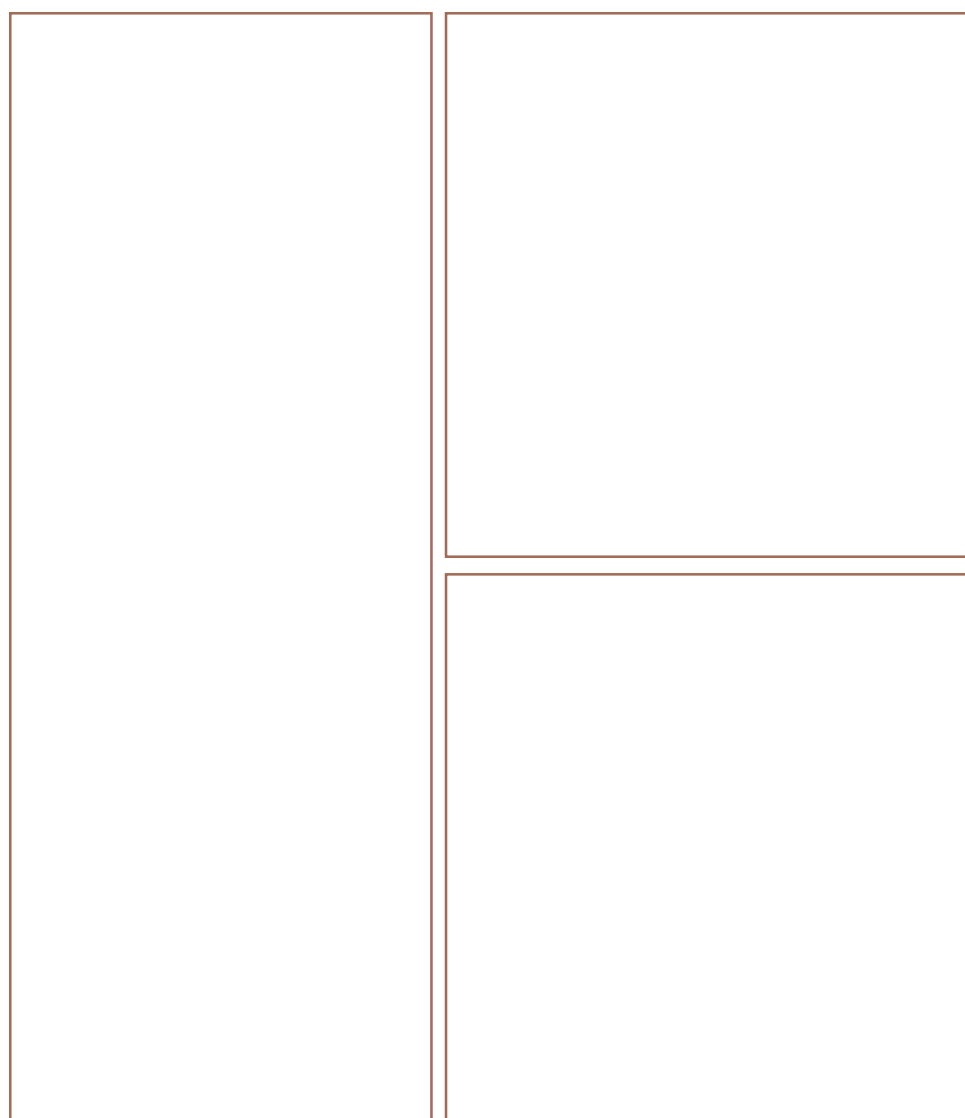

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## INTRODUCTION

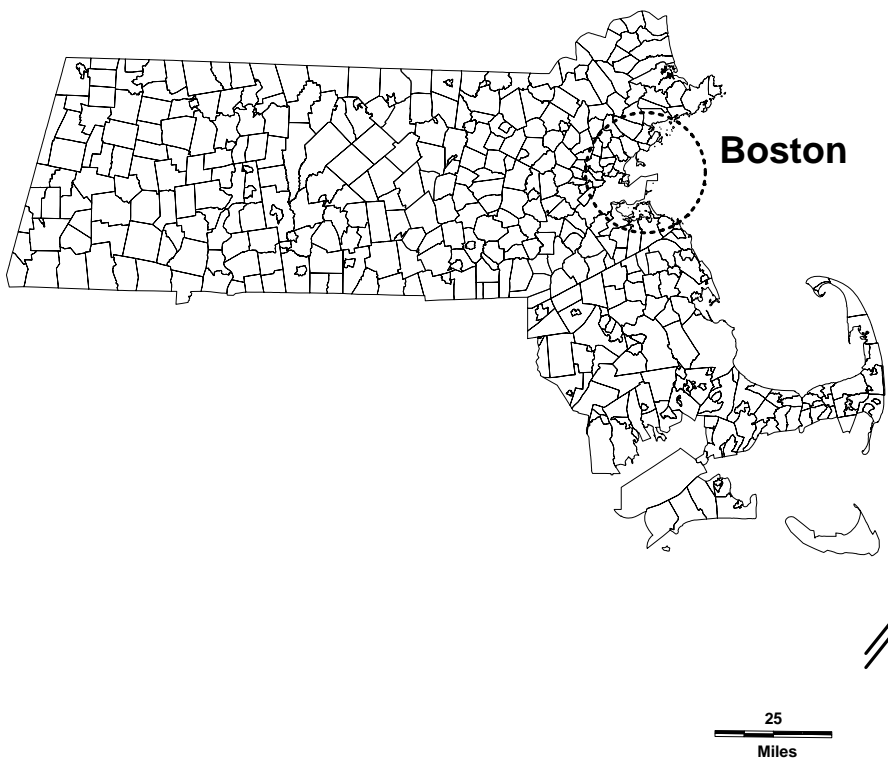

The maps included in this compilation reflect the latest version of those definitions and boundaries.

### **Technical Notes for Printing off the Web:**

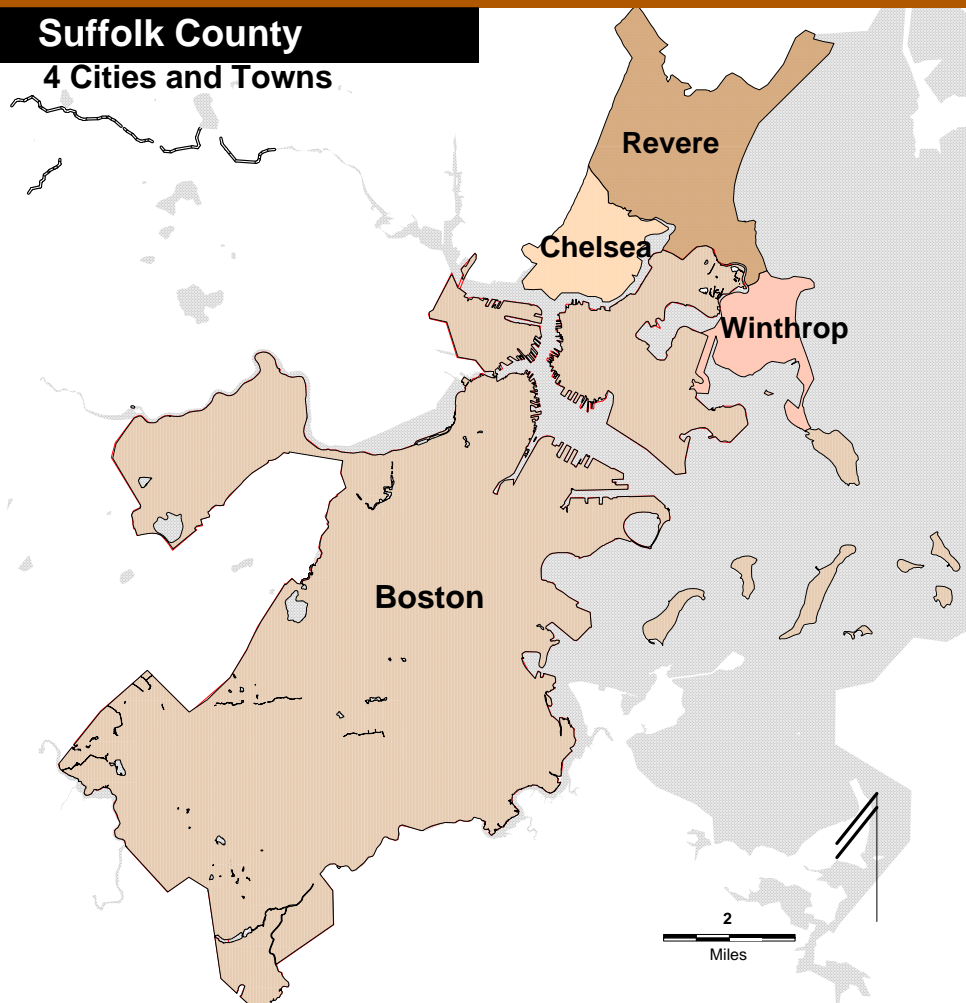

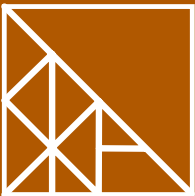
BOSTON PLANNING DISTRICTS AND NOTABLE LOCATIONS

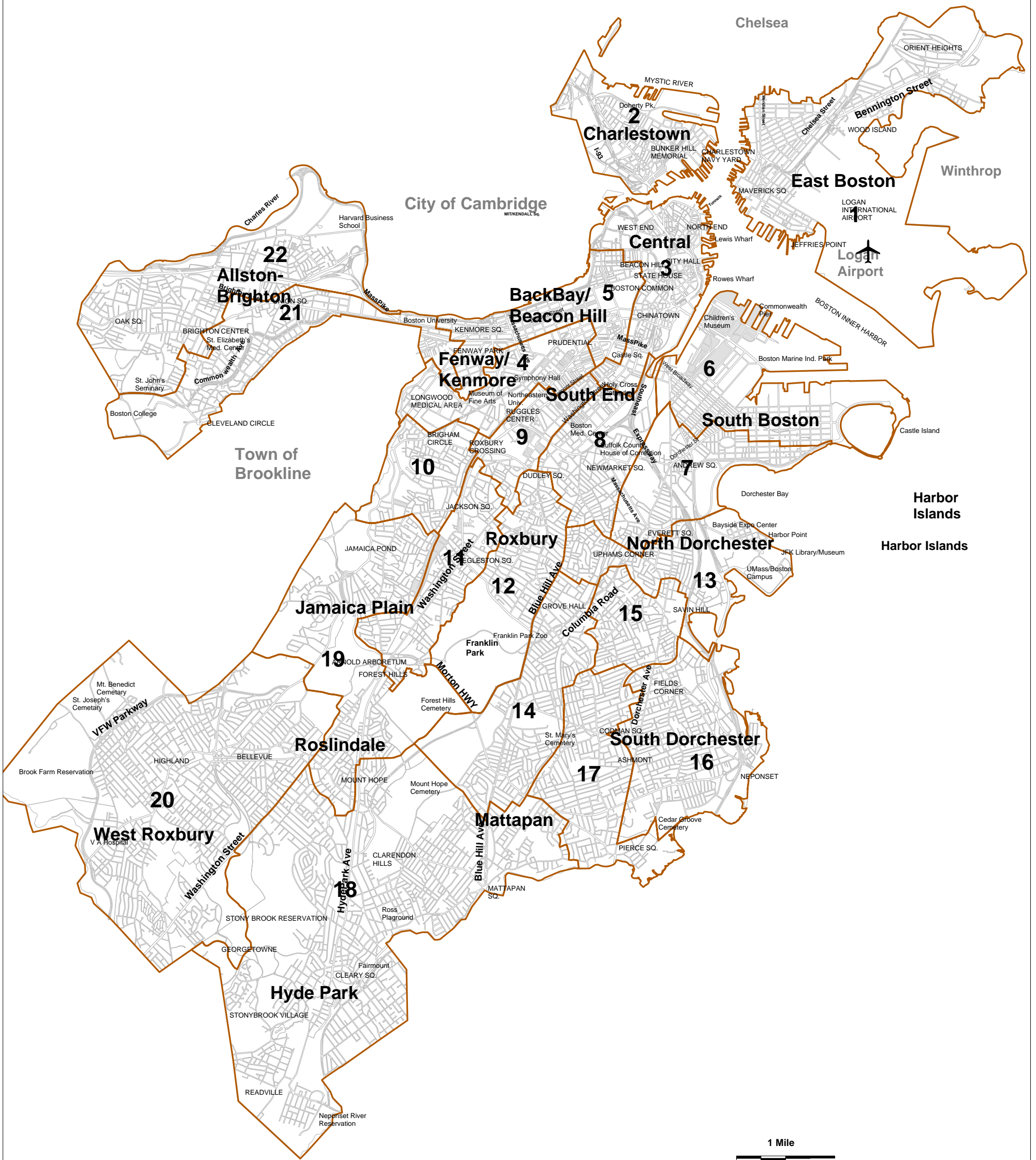

Planning District Boundary







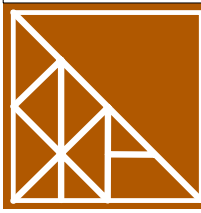


BOSTON ELECTORAL DISTRICTS

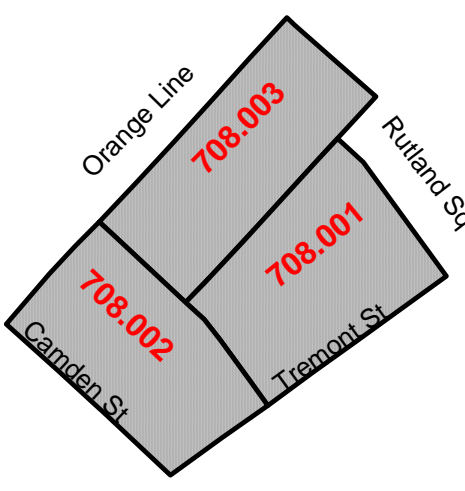

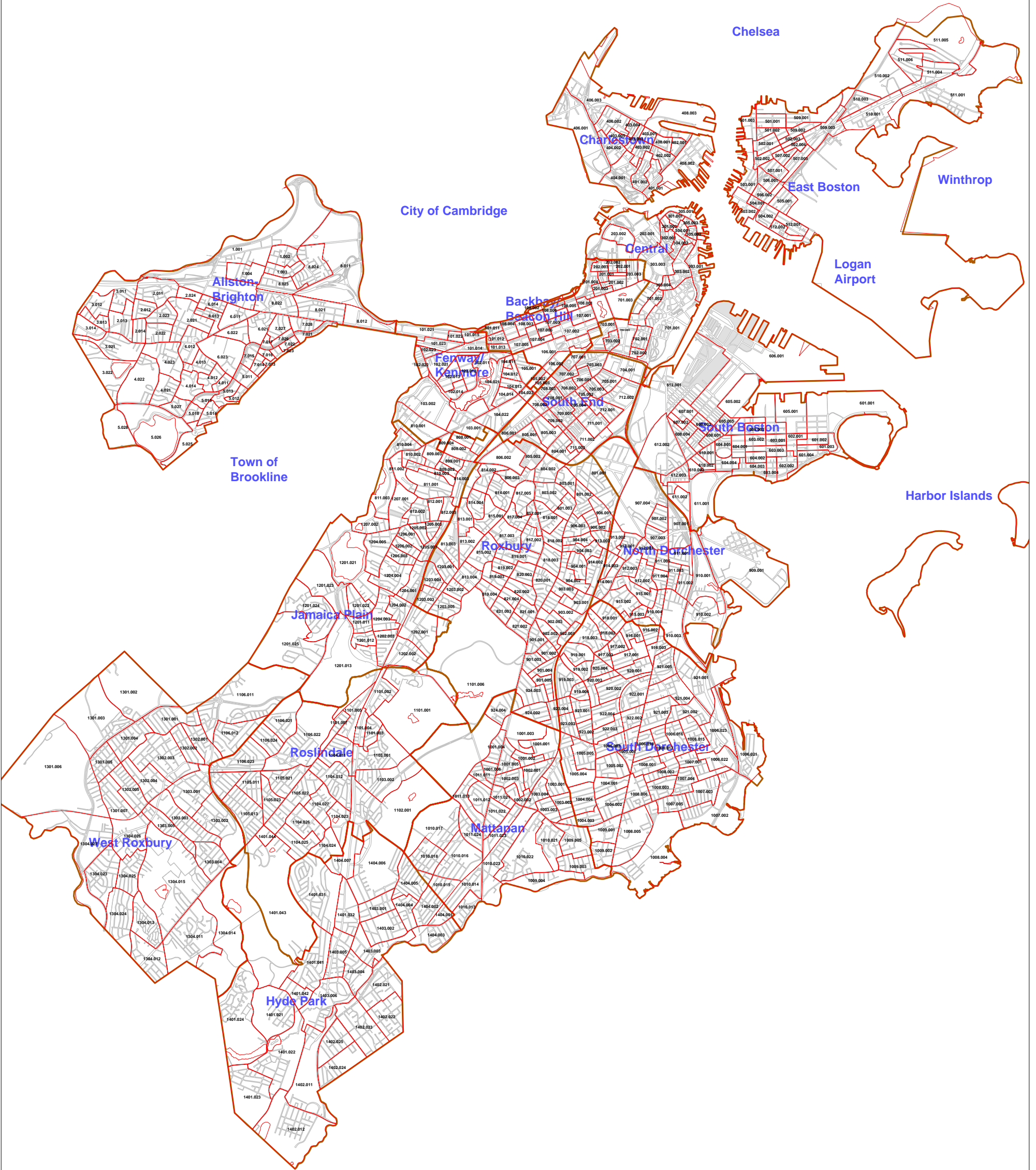

Census Tract Boundaries with their ID #s





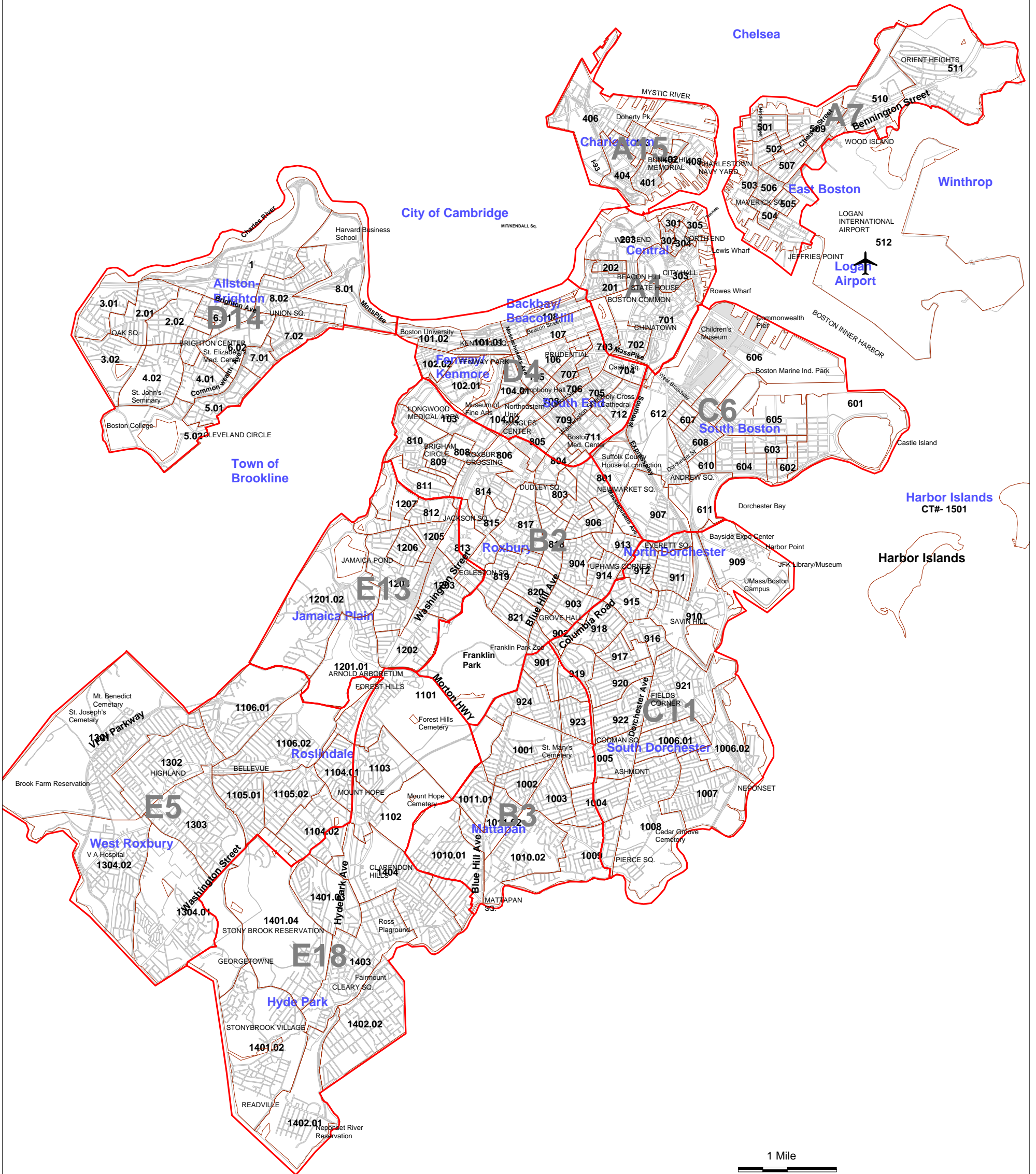

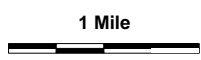
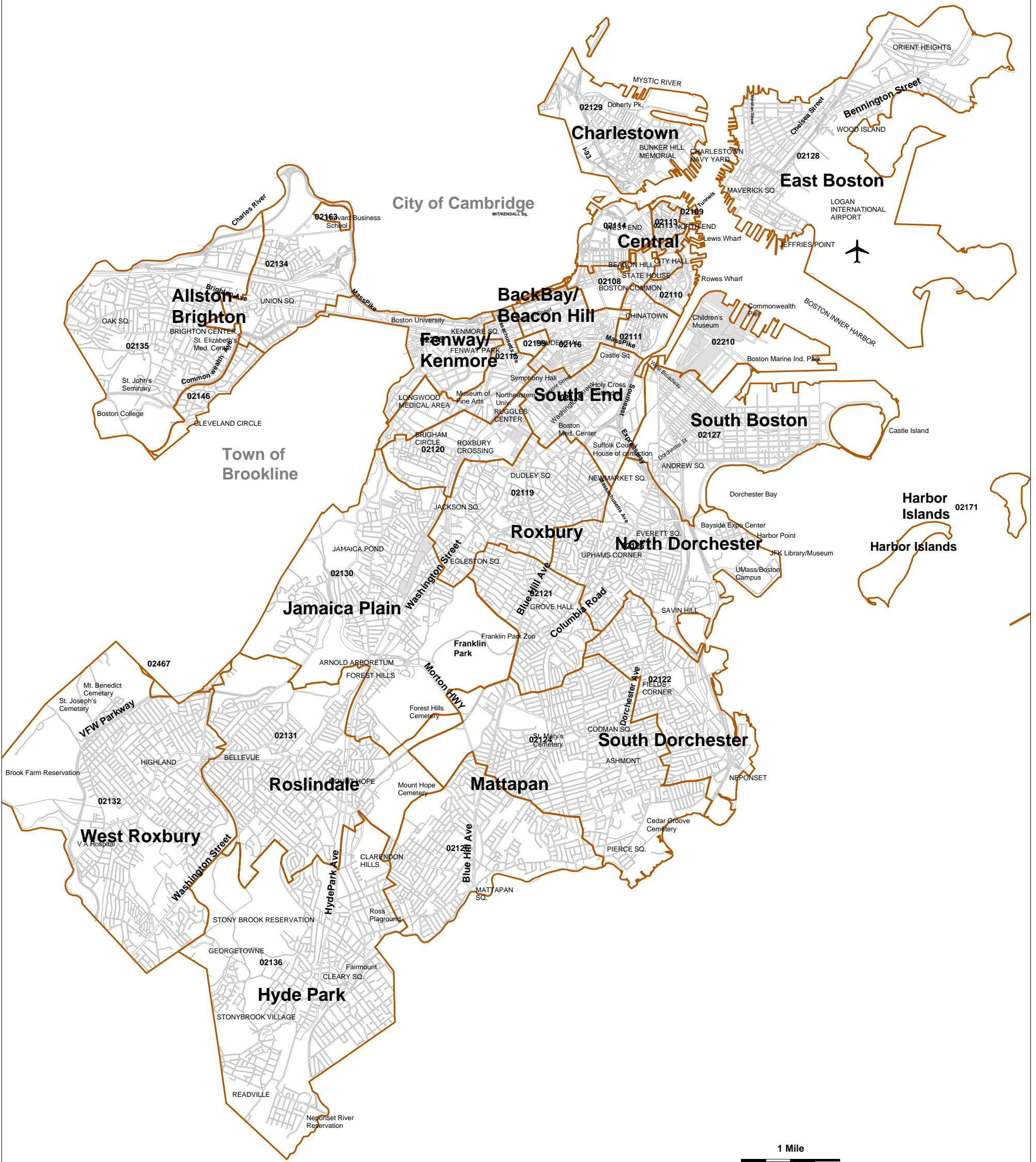
Census Tracts that changed between 1990-2000

BOSTON ZIP CODE DISTRICTS

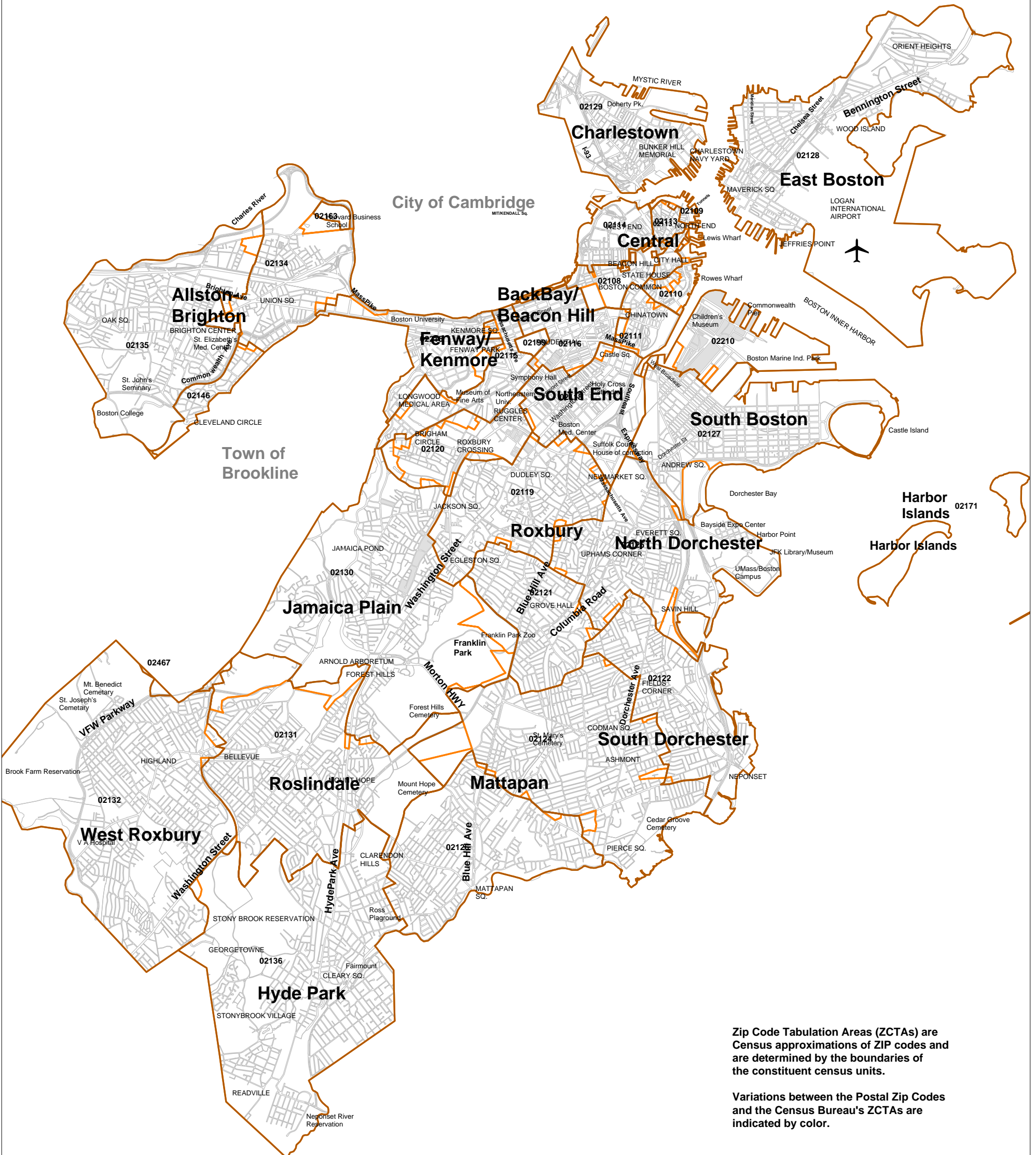

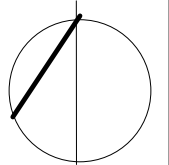
