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## Boston in Context-Planning Districts

*Boston in Context-Planning Districts* is a document that compares the United States, Massachusetts, Boston, and Boston's Planning Districts across several social, economic, and housing characteristics. These data are a combination of 2010 U.S. Census data and 2006-2010 American Community Survey data.

Planning Districts are legacy geographies used by the Boston Redevelopment Authority. Due to differences in how data are compiled, the geographies for Boston's Planning Districts will be slightly different between U.S. Census data and the ACS. For our Census data, Planning Districts were defined by Census Blocks. However, the vast majority of ACS data are only available at the Tract level. When Census Tracts were split by Planning District boundaries, 2010 Census Block data were consulted. In each case, the Census Tract was assigned to the Planning District where the higher concentration of residents lived at the Block level in 2010. Census Tract 981502 is partially in East Boston and partially in Revere. When aggregating ACS data for the American Fact Finder website, the Census Bureau assigned the entire population of this tract to Revere. As a result, we exclude tract 981502 from our aggregations of ACS data for East Boston in this report. Census Tract 990101 is unassigned to a Planning District. As a result, the aggregate of all Planning District data does not equal the total for Boston.
